Jury Procedures for New Resident Artist

The following process will be used when studio space or spaces become(s) vacant in The Arts Center @ 319. Artists invited to apply for studio space will include, but not be limited to those names on any waiting list maintained by the Arts Center Director. At the discretion of the Board of Directors, the vacancy may or may not be advertised publicly.

The Applicant must submit the following:

1. A small portfolio showing a representative overview of his or her work
2. A resume stating art related education, experience, awards, etc.
3. At least two original pieces of art which are framed and/or ready for presentation/exhibition

The Jury will be composed of:

1. A majority of the Resident Artists holding current leases
2. No fewer than two Members of the Board of Directors
3. The Art Center Director

If the Applicant's submissions are approved by the jury, the Applicant will be granted an interview in person by the Jury Committee. The Jury Committee will decide if a lease will be offered to the applicant. If a lease is offered, the Applicant must accept within 30 days or it will be null and void.
