

Call for Entries
“Written Words”

Artists and Authors
January 2 to February 8, 2019



All artwork depicting WRITING or WRITTEN WORDS in all forms is eligible! Authors and Artists invited.

Grown from the traditional collaboration of the Isle of Wight Writers Group and the Isle of Wight Arts League, this exhibit is open to submissions from all visual artists and writers. Authors are invited to submit their written works and artists their interpretation of “words” in visual arts.



OPENING RECEPTION: Saturday, January 5, 2019 from 2:00 to 5:00pm for the artists, their families and friends.
With special events: Authors of the Isle of Wight Writers Group and other writers in the exhibit provide a reading of original works.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all authors, artists, photographers, sculptors and artisans. Each artist may submit up to two artworks. The Isle of Wight Arts League retains 30% commission on sales.

REQUIREMENTS:

Visual arts: All entries must be original in design and content and must have been completed in the last two years and ready for proper display. Art work cannot have been included in a previous exhibit held in the Arts Center. Two-dimensional and three-dimensional works weighing less than 45 pounds in **any** media are eligible. 3-D works cannot be of dimensions that impact activities or accessibility within the gallery space. Two-dimensional artwork must have D-Ring mounting hangers permanently attached to the frame and identification on the back with the title, medium, and artists' name. 3-D artwork must have identification attached also. *Damaged work will not be accepted.* Work will be considered suitable for display in the gallery by the director of the Arts Center @ 319 at her discretion.

Written work may be printed and made ready for display (framed, mounted, etc.) by the author, or submitted electronically to be printed and prepared for display in the exhibit by staff and volunteers of the gallery. The general format for gallery presentation will be printed on paper 8.5 by 11 inches in size and single page works are preferred.

DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES: Artists need to submit the entry form and images of the pieces for display either by mail to the Arts Center @ 319, 319-A Main Street, Smithfield, VA 23430, or emailed to info@SmithfieldArts.org **no later than December 20, 2018**. Artists will be notified on December 22 of acceptance to the exhibit.

DELIVERY: Friday and Saturday, December 28 and 29, 2018, 9am-5pm Work may be for sale or marked NFS and **MUST REMAIN ON DISPLAY** for the duration of the exhibit.

PICK-UP: Sunday February 8 and 9, 2019, 9am-5pm. Any work that is not picked up within 10 days after this date will become property of the Arts Center @ 319.
